The background

International representation of Franco-Flemish culture

With this festival, the Huelgas Ensemble emphasizes its function as Cultural Ambassador of Flemish Heritage. The choice to organize the festival in Burgundy is no coincidence. The Burgundian Court was a leading political entity for the emergence of polyphony. The Burgundian chapel had the best Franco-Flemish singers and composers, so that the Dijon-Flanders axis was supported by a strong musical tradition. Across borders, Talant has become a foreign meeting place, support and disribution point for the spread of our own culture. This fact, incidentally, is an endorsement of cultural policy as it is prescribed in the text about the cultural spread of the new Flemish government. After the reactions to the first Whitsun festival of the Huelgas Ensemble in Talant from both the international public, press and media, it is clear that after the first edition, the festival has already become legendary. We are convinced, given the great response from the public, that the festival will, in the future, continue to occupy a permanent place in the landscape of European music festivals.

Audience target

As was already evident in the first two editions, the festival appeals to an international audience. The two largest groups came from France (from Burgundy, but also from other regions such as Paris and Lyon) and from Belgium. But the festival was also visited by enthusiasts and concert organizers from Switzerland (Geneva), Germany, Austria, The Netherlands, England, Australia and Cuba. The first two festivals already attracted each more than 1,100 visitors, a number that, given the demand for reservations that are already being made, will certainly increase for the 2023 edition.

Documentation

During the festival of 2023, the classical radio station Klara will send the producer Mark Janssens to Talant to make a full documentary of the three-day event, just like in 2019 and 2022. Moreover, in 2019 all the concerts were recorded by Sony Music. The result is the release of a CD double album that clearly illustrates the versatility and innovation of the festival. Similar recordings are also planned for 2023, which will be distributed around the world by Sony. In addition, a number of music journalists from the international press will be invited in 2023.
